How It All Began...

In 1979, a group of licensed child care providers met to help form what is now known as the “Scott County Licensed Family Child Care Association”. These providers came together to find help with their child care business and support in their daily life as a provider. They came together to form friendships with people who understood what a difficult job they had chosen as their profession.

In 1980, the legal by-laws were drawn up and the association was incorporated as an independent, non-profit organization. Providers were encouraged to join the association in order for the group to become a strong support system for all providers in Scott County.

Each month, an association meeting was held for all members. Garage sales, bake sales, workshops and boutiques were held to raise money for training for providers. Eventually, the association was able to offer all-day conferences to providers to expand their training.

A referral service for providers and parents to help place children in child care was started by the association several years after incorporation. This service was provided on a volunteer basis by child care providers.

The association then applied for a grant from the State of Minnesota in 1987 to expand the referral service. In 1988, the SCLFCCA became the first child care association to be awarded a grant for a computerized referral service.

Today, we are 300+ members strong & continue to work to make the field of family child care one that is rich in professionalism and quality; supporting providers in Scott County in multiple ways.
